International Team Certificate (ITC)	Do we have to list our players and officials before the tournament?	Yes	The IISHF provides a document "International Team Certicifiate". This document can be downloaded from IISHF website "www.iishf.com".				
Deadline for ITC	Is there a deadline to send the ITC?	Yes	The deadline is 2 weeks before the tournament. We recommend all teams to put all possible players on the ITC to be sure that no modified ITC has later to be applied for (which only causes additional costs).

Deadline to produce Players identity?	Is there a deadline for the proof of the players eligibility to play?	Yes	The passport or National identy card of each player must be provided to the Technical Director within fifteen (15) minutes prior to the Manager Meeting.				
Manager Meeting	Must a team take part at the Manager Meeting?	l I	One English speaking Manager (person) from each team must be present at the Manager Meeting, but as maximum 2 persons per Team.

Players list	Do we need to provide a players list before each game?	Yes	All players and officials have to be listed.
Deadline for Players li	st Is there a deadline for providing the players list?	Yes	At least 30 minutes before each game, a team official or the captain of a team shall submit to the Technical Director or the Technical Director's office a list of players who are eligible to play in that game indicating all shirt numbers.
Number of Players	'Is there a regulation for the number of players per each game?	Yes	The maximum number of players that may be registered as members of a team for any game is 18 (as listed in the Match Report). All teams must have a minimum of 8 players – these players must be kitted up and be on the players bench or on the pitch for the first game of the tournament.
Equipment	Is there a rule for matching equipment?	Yes	All the players of each team must have matching equipment and must fully apply with rules 5.2 (players uniform) and 5.3 (players numbers) in IISHF Rules of the Game.
Bench Official	Can each person be a Bench Official?	No	Each team, except senior teams, must have at least one bench official (rule 4.2.3). All persons except players kitted up and listed on the match report will be deemed to be a bench official. Only players listed on the match report and a maximum of 5 bench officials (with a minimum age of 18 years) are allowed to be on the bench.
