

### Points for any other business on IISHF Working Meeting

- 1) At the beginning of the year, we wrote an important email to the IISHF Presidium asking for an opinion on a matter. IISHF Presidium confirmed acceptance and stated that within one week we would get a reply. After one week without response we kindly reminded. Until today we did not get a reply and are disappointed about the behaviour and cooperation of IISHF Presidium.
- 2) According to § 18.5 IISHF Constitution at all IISHF meetings (e.g. working group) minutes must be recorded and be dispatched to all members of the relevant body. For the IISHF Working Groups this has not been done in 2022 and we hereby kindly request IISHF Presidium in future to accordingly follow and comply with IISHF Constitution.
- 3) In 2022 cases have occurred that an IISHF Presidium member has made unjustified allegations against our NMA behind our back. We have clearly expressed our anger and incomprehension to the person concerned and expect for future that all IISHF Presidium Members do not defame any country to third persons.
- 4) The IISHF Presidium has to develop a detailed IISHF Website and Social Media Manual until the end of 2023. This manual shall include all the requests of NMAs which topics and in which manner topics are published. In 2022 articles were published on IISHF platforms which due to our opinion damages the reputation of NMAs and of IISHF. This manual shall be approved by the Council of Members.
- 5) We have to take note that some NMAs criticize other countries in public (social) networks, and obviously there are different opinions about the style and type of mutual cooperation among NMAs.  
But completely unacceptable for us are criticism in networks against hosts of title events and IISHF officials (e.g. named referees). This has nothing to do with sportsmanship and fairness and thus we appeal to all NMAs and IISHF Presidium in future to objectively present justified criticism to the right bodies and not to act in a populist manner.
- 6) IISHF shall annually check in detail the team registration of all member countries (NMAs). In the event of erroneous reporting resulting in a change in voting rights, strict legal consequences must be taken by IISHF and reported to the Council of Members.
