1. IISHF will provide sponsorship for the U19 European Championship 2017

The IISHF Presidium has decided to sponsor the hosting club/hosting NMA with a sponsorship of 3000 Euro. In our opinion this is the most important Title Event every year because these national teams represent the future of our sport.

National Member Associations (NMA's) that we will apply for the U19 European Championships 2017 in the months September – November both months included should do so latest by December 31, 2016.

The funding for this sponsorship is taken from the IISHF fines and fees collected during the season 2016 which is then can be reinvested to the benefit of the sport. The IISHF Presidium will take the topic sponsorship up for further discussion at the IISHF AGM 2017 in Kiev, Ukraine in the end of February 2017.

2. Veterans European Cup 2017

The Swiss Federation has informed IISHF that they are considering hosting the Veterans European Cup 2017 and the Danish Federation has informed IISHF that they are willing to be backup host. Final deadline for formal application for this event even by other NMA's is set to December 31, 2016.

3. AGM 2017

André Poddubny who is the Chairman of the Technical Committee Inline-Skater Hockey in the Ukrainian Federation of Roller Sports has provided the following practical information to IISHF on Wednesday December 14, 2016 about the upcoming AGM 2017 which will take place in Kiev, Ukraine on February 24-26, 2017.

I, herewith, would like to inform you that we have chosen the President Hotel for the AGM. We concluded our negotiations only yesterday and sign two agreements today. By tomorrow I will make a prepayment secure the conference services (room, coffee breaks, lunch). By February 14th I will have to pay the remainder in full. In the meantime we will have to select the menus for lunch and coffee breaks, so to determine the final amount due.

Please find attached the official booking form of the hotel for all participants. This form should be filled out and sent by the participants directly to the Hotel before February 16th, 2017. May I also kindly ask that a copy be sent to my assistant Dmytro who will be in charge of all organizational matters before, during and after the AGM.

We also need to learn if there are vegetarians or vegans among the participants. In addition, we will be happy to assist with the transfers from and to the airport. For this purpose please ask all participants to share with us their time of arrival in Kyiv, their airport of arrival, airline, and their airport of origin.

We agreed on special prices with the hotel as can be seen in the booking form. Payment can be made either via credit card or cash at the hotel. Check in at the hotel is 14:00, check out is 12:00. For an early arrival starting 6:30 in the morning 50% of the room price will be charged extra. For a late checkout until 18:00 a 50% room price will be charged extra. A check out later than 18:00 necessitates the payment of another night.

Kyiv (Kiev) has two airports. The Boryspil international Airport (KBP) and the International airport KYIV (IEV). The latter is used mainly by the low-cost carrier Wizz Air.
