1. Age limits for the IISHF Veterans European Cup 2021

The IISHF Official Rule Book 2020/2021 states the following in §4.1.2 (VETERANS (WOMEN/MEN)):

Lower Limit: A player who on completion of the current calendar year is 35 years of age or older.

So the following age limit will apply for the IISHF Veterans European Cup 2021:

There is no upper age limit for players participating at the IISHF Veterans European Cup 2021. The lower age limit for participating players at the IISHF Veterans European Cup 2021 is generally any player born in 1986 (youngest).

2. Gentofte Veterans Invitation Cup – B Event

The event will take place on August 22+23, 2020 in Gentofte, Denmark. It was originally planned solely as an International B-Event but due to the uncertain times currently the setup for the event has been changed. The event will take place now as the Danish National Veterans Championship 2020 but at the same time it will be open for international participation as an Open Danish Veterans Championship. For the moment one German team and two teams from Great Britain have shown interest in participating. However for the moment a foreign visit to Denmark from the two mentioned countries is possible but it's required that the visitors book a minimum of 6 overnights stay with proof of the accommodation booking made. Unless this restriction will be changed it's difficult to envision foreign participation. The hosting club has extended the deadline for participation until Friday August 14th of 2020.

3. IHC Malcantone from Switzerland participating at the IISHF Men European Cup 2021

There was a mistake in the listing of the teams participating at the IISHF Men European Cup 2021 as published in the IISHF Communication Letter 2020-15 as of June 7, 2020 it's IHC Malcantone and not SHC Givisiez that has the 12th place at the event.
