2. IISHF Working Groups - update

Switzerland has announced that Daniel Taschner will take part in the IISHF Working group on Rules. Attached please find a revised list of the 3 current IISHF Working Groups.

3. Rules of the Game – updated version

As mentioned in the minutes from the EGM 2010 (see above) a proposal for corrections of a number of minor adjustments were presented and approved (see also IISHF Communication Letter 2010-12).

As attachment you will get the following documents:

- The Correction-version which has the change-marks included (in the common red/green-notation).
- The Final-version is the version with the green change-marks being replaced by the common blue-font-colour.

4. Deadline for Team informations

Each National Member Association must inform the IISHF before the 31st of December each year of the Team names, contact person, full team list and contact address (e-mail) of the National Champion and National Vice Champion and any Host with Wild Card Teams for U19, U16 and U13 for that year.

For the Men and Women National Champion and National Vice Champion and any Host with Wild Card or defending European Cup Title Holder in those age groups the Team names, contact person and contact address (e-mail) should be provided. The above request also applies for the teams that could/would participate in the Men Invitation Cup.

5. AGM – Annual General Meeting 2011

The Annual General Meeting of the IISHF will as previously announced take place the weekend of February 26-27, 2011 in Amsterdam, Netherland. The IISHF Presidium will shortly provide more information about place and accommodation.

6. Inquiry regarding Veterans Cup/Old Boys Men

We have received an inquiry from BISHA about the potential interest from the National Member Associations in participating in a Title Event in either Old Boys (Men) as an European Championship or as a club title event as the Old Boys Invitation Cup. An Old Boys Men player is defined as a player who on completion of the current calendar year is 32 years of age or older.

For your information please note that an European Cup can only take place with teams from a minimum of three (3) different Nations. An European Championship can only take place with teams from a minimum of four (4) different nations.

Please give us your feedback latest by Sunday January 9, 2011 if your club teams and/or National Team would be willing to participate in such an event in the future.
