

IISHF Rules of the Game – Proposal - Denmark

Proposal for correction of §5.11.1 (Goalkeepers Equipment) and addition to §5.16.3 (Goalkeepers Leg Guards).

Green: Inserted text

Proposed corrected text (Goalkeepers Equipment):

§5.11.1

With the exception of skates and stick, all the equipment worn by the goalkeeper shall be constructed solely for the purpose of protecting the head and the body **or protecting the equipment from unnecessary wear and damage** and shall not include any garment or addition which would give the goalkeeper undue assistance in keeping goal. Abdominal aprons, extending down the front of the thighs on the outside of the pants, are prohibited.

⇒ The argument for correcting the text is that the Goalkeeper should be allowed to protect their equipment from unnecessary damage.

New text (Goalkeepers Leg Guards)

§5.16.3

A manufactured or homemade piece of plastic, rubber or leather, is allowed to be securely fixed to the inside of the pad, in order to protect it from wear and damage. Any additions to the leg guards must not extend the width of the leg guards as defined in rule 5.16.1. Any additions in this manner are optional.

⇒ The argument for adding the text is that the Goalkeeper should be allowed to protect their equipment from unnecessary wear and damage.
