1. Suspension for Pakistan has been lifted

As of July 6, 2012 the suspension for Pakistan has been lifted since they have paid their outstanding payment to IISHF. Thus with immediate effect from July 6, 2012 all Pakistan teams are allowed again to take part at international events.

In reference to the IISHF Communication Letter 2012-08 now only Canada is suspended and no team from that country shall be allowed to take part at any international (A and/or B) event until their payments have been settled.

2. Tournament Rules and Time Schedules for the U19/Junior and Men European Championship 2012

As attachment you will get the final TOURNAMENT RULES and final TIME SCHEDULES of the following European Championships 2012.

- U19/Junior European Championship 2012 in Aarhus (Denmark).
- Men European Championship 2012 in Givisiez (Switzerland).

Please transfer these documents a.s.a.p. to your teams participating. In case of any questions to accommodation and organisation, the teams shall please contact the relevant Event Directors as mentioned in the Tournament Rules.

3. Deadline for Teams participating in the U19/Junior and Men European Championship 2012

As already mentioned in the IISHF Communication Letter 2012-03 the IISHF Presidium has according to point 12.1 IISHF Constitution (2012 version) imposed an official deadline for all Teams participating in the U19/Junior and Men European Championships 2012 to send the following material. Deadline is set to 4 weeks before each event.

- a) an actual team photo
- b) victories / successes of the last 10 years for the relevant team (age group) in English language and a short story (history) of the team
- c) players list with names and shirt numbers of all players.
- d) team logo

Until 07.09.2012 for the U19 Junior European Championship 2012 in Aarhus, Denmark.

Until 20.09.2012 for the Men European Championship 2012 in Givisiez, Switzerland.

Complete information has to be sent by e-mail to the hosting club with a copy (!!) to the IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com or sommer.erik@gmail.com). Failure will result to fixed fines (50 EUR per week of delay).

Please also pay attention that each National Member Association has to send not later than two weeks before each European Cup the completed and approved International Team Certificate (ITC) of all its teams to IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com or sommer.erik@gmail.com).

4. Revised Time Schedule for the Men Cup Winner Cup 2012

As attachment you will get the revised final TIME SCHEDULE of the following European Cup 2012.

- Men Cup Winner Cup 2012 in Aarhus (Denmark).

Please transfer this document a.s.a.p. to your teams participating. The schedules have been changed regarding the matching of teams for games 25+26 and games 28+29 in order to ensure a more likely matchup with teams from the various groups.

5. Approval of Equipment

The IISHF Technical Committee has granted the permission to use a modified helmet to a German player according to the Rules of the Game 5.1.3.

The decision has been made according to the current standard procedure with 4 members taking part in the vote (the German member was not entitled to vote on a German case). The permission has been granted with a 4:0 vote satisfying the required 2/3 majority. The permission is valid until December 31st 2012.

The attached approval document is hereby distributed to all member countries and is available to all Technical Directors at international events - even though it is highly unlikely that the player will take part in any international event.
