2. Title Events 2013 – Tournaments scheduled

The following Title Events 2013 have at the moment been scheduled:

- U13 European Cup in Givisiez (Switzerland) on June 8-9, 2013.
- Men Cup Winner Cup in Givisiez (Switzerland) on August 31 – September 1, 2013.

For the following event we have a candidate (deadline for application was November 15, 2012):

- Men European Championship in Rødovre (Denmark).

3. Title Events 2013 – Applications requested

IISHF also welcomes applications for all other Title Events in 2013. Deadline for presenting an application for any of the other events is extended to **15.12.2012**. We urgently ask all NGB's to deliver this request to all their clubs and teams with the remark that without any hosts we can't arrange IISHF Title Events.

4. International Referee Course 2013

On the weekend of 16-17 March 2013 an International Referee Course will take place in Stegersbach (Austria) where all existing International Referees should take part.

A list of the existing IISHF referees is attached and we ask all NMAs to immediately inform your referees about this course. We will inform all these referees lately at the beginning of January about the details (travelling, accommodation, time schedule) – the referees shall please make sure that they shall attend this course (arrival to be expected Friday evening and departure Sunday afternoon at 3 PM from Stegersbach). The course will be completely paid by IISHF. Each NGB shall please reply and confirm lately until 15.12.2012 to IISHF Vice President Jean-Daniel Muller which referee will take part at the course.

We also ask the NMA's to let us know if they are interested to send a new person to this International Referee Course who may be qualified as international referee and who may attend this course. In case of any interest please send the relevant Application with the attached Form Sheet for New International Referee until 15.12.2012 to IISHF Vice President Jean-Daniel Muller.

5. International Technical Director and Official Course 2013

On the weekend of 16-17 March 2013 an International Technical Director (TD) and Official Course will also take place in Stegersbach (Austria). IISHF will invite the participants.

6. Survey – financial support provided for teams participating in European Cups and European Championships

BISHA (Great Britain) has asked for a survey to be conducted among the member countries regarding the financial support provided for teams participating in European Cups and European Championships “BISHA requests that the member countries tell us how much, if any, help is provided for their Cup teams and their National teams”?

In regards to the request from BISHA we would ask all Member Countries to provide information regarding the following 3 points about your financial procedure:

- 1) Financial Procedure for National Teams and National Players.
- 2) Financial Procedure for Teams to take part at European Cups.
- 3) Financial Procedure for Teams to host Title Events.
