## **1. Proposals from IISHF Technical Committee for IISHF Rule Changes**

As attachment please find the following document:

Stefan Gehrig the Chairman of the IISHF Technical Committee has added the following information:

Please find attached the IISHF Technical Committee's proposal for the 2013 rule book for further distribution to the member countries. The proposal includes accepted proposals from Germany and from the Committee itself. A Danish proposal has been declined but will most likely be put forward to the AGM by the Danish federation for an additional vote. Several German proposals have been declined as well, but they'll not be put forward to the AGM for additional voting.

The changes are marked with the common red/green marking and there is a section marked in purple that denotes the changes already accepted at the AGM 2012 for the 2013 rule book. I'll briefly summarize the changes:

6.2. In a regular game there should be a defined warm-up period for each team; this rule can be adjusted for tournament-like events where it's not possible to allow the teams a full warm-up period.

7.1.5 Clarification.

7.15.7 Movement of face-off; in situations where only one team receives a minor, major, major plus game misconduct, match or gross match penalty the face-off will be moved to the offender's net. (That was also an Austrian proposal which reached the committee far too late to include them into the internal voting).

## **2. Title Events 2013 – Tournaments scheduled**

The following Title Events 2013 have at the moment been scheduled and sanctioned:

- U13 European Cup in Givisiez (Switzerland) on June 8-9, 2013 (A2013-01).
- Men Cup Winner Cup in Givisiez (Switzerland) on August 31 – September 1, 2013 (A2013-02).
- Men European Championship in Rødovre (Denmark) on October 25-27, 2013 (A2013-03).

The following Title Events 2013 have at the moment been scheduled:

- European Cup Men in Delémont (Switzerland) on July 5-7, 2013.
- European Cup Old Boys in Rødovre (Denmark) on July 19-21, 2013.
- Junior European Championship in Düsseldorf (Germany) on November 2-3, 2013.

For the following event we have a candidate (deadline for application was December 15, 2012):

- European Cup U16 in Kfar Saba (Israel) on June 15-16, 2013.

### **3. Title Events 2013 and 2014 – Applications requested**

IISHF request applications for all remaining other Title Events in 2013 and for all Title Events in 2014. Deadline for presenting an application for any of the other events is now extended to **15.01.2013**. We urgently ask all NGB's to deliver this request to all their clubs and teams with the remark that without any hosts we can't arrange IISHF Title Events.
