1. U16 European Cup 2013 to be hosted in Kaarst (Germany)

The U16 European Cup will be hosted by the club Crash Eagles Kaarst on 15./16.06.2013 in Kaarst (Germany). The tournament will take place on a 22 by 43 meter plastic pitch in the new Stadtparkhalle build by the town on the old ground of the Dreifachturnhalle.

With effect from 09.02.2013 the official IISHF announcement of the U16 European Cup 2013 has been done. The event is now listed on www.iisfh.com. As attachment all National Member Associations (NMA's) now receive the IISHF Seeding Ranking List 2013 for the U16 European Cup with update as of today for the U16 European Cup 2013. In this list all teams (incl. Backup teams) are mentioned who are qualified to take part.

Regarding the European Cups (Club Teams) according to Point 18.2 IISHF Regulations each National Champion 2012 must take part in the European Cup 2013, unless they officially cancel their participation to the IISHF within three (3) weeks after the European Cup has been announced. The need for feedback also apply for all National Vice Champions 2013, Wild Card Teams, Host Teams and Backup Teams who might qualified for 2013 so please make sure that the final information about the participation 2013 of all

your Club Teams as listed in the IISHF Seeding Ranking List will be given at latest within the next three weeks to IISHF (office@iishf.com) with copy to sommer.erik@gmail.com. Deadline for reply is 02.03.2013. In the event of a National Champion declining the place, the place will in the first instance be offered to that National Member Associations Vice-Champion if they do not already have a place.

2. Teams participating at Title Events 2013

Attached please find a listing of the teams selected to participate in the Title Events 2013. For the European Championships for Men and Juniors (U19) more countries can still participate. We will accept applications with deadline 01.04.2013.

3. Deadline for Teams participating in European Cups 2013

We hereby officially announce that according to point 12.1 IISHF Constitution (2012 version) the IISHF Presidium has imposed an official deadline for all Teams participating in European Cups 2013 to send the following material. Deadline is set to 4 weeks before each event.

- a) **An actual team photo**
- b) **Victories / successes of the last 10 years for the relevant team (age group) in English language and a short story (history) of the team**
- c) **Players list with names and shirt numbers of all players.**
- d) **Team logo**

Deadline has been fixed for the following European Cup so far:

- Until 10.05.2013 for U13 Pee Wee European Cup 2013 in Givisiez (Switzerland).

Complete information has to be sent by e-mail to the hosting club with a copy (!!) to the IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com). Failure will result to fixed fines (50 EUR per week of delay).

Please also pay attention that each National Member Association has to send not later than two weeks before each European Cup the completed and approved International Team Certificate (ITC) of all its teams to IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com).

The Time Schedule and Tournament Rules will be sent out with a following IISHF Communication Letter in timely manner before the event.

Information for U19 and U16 European Cup 2013 will follow later since the deadline for feedback is still open. For the Old Boys European Cup, Men European Cup and Men Cup Winner Cup the information will follow when the final selection of teams has taken place.

4. Deadline for Teams participating in European Championships 2013

We hereby officially announce that according to point 12.1 IISHF Constitution the IISHF Presidium has imposed an official deadline for all National Teams participating in European Championships 2013 to send the following material:

- a) An actual team photo.
 - b) Victories / successes of the last 10 years for the relevant team (age group) in English language and a short story (history) of the team.
 - c) Players list with names and shirt numbers of all players (please indicate players position).
 - d) Team logo
- Until 26.09.2013 for Team Information Men European Championships in Rødovre (Denmark).
 - Until 04.10.2013 for Team Information Junior European Championships in Düsseldorf (Germany).

Complete information has to be sent by e-mail to the hosting club with a copy (!!) to the IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com). Failure will result to fixed fines (50 EUR per week of delay).

Please also pay attention that each National Member Association has to send not later than two weeks before each European Championship the completed and approved International Team Certificate (ITC) of all its teams to IISHF President Erik Sommer (esommer@iishf.com).
