# Returning member countries

Last country to rejoin IISHF was the Netherlands who was absent in the years 2003-2004.



# Number of A-events hosted

53 title events were hosted (out of potential 58 events).

3 years in a row (2007, 2008 and 2009) all events were hosted. This was not the case in 2010 (6 events) and 2011 and 2012 (8 events – potential from 2011 is 9 events) .

2011, 2012:	8 events (new)
2007, 2008, 2009:	8 events (old)
2004, 2006:	7 events
2010:	6 events
2005:	5 events

# Non A-events hosted

5 title events (out of a potential of 58 events) were not hosted the last 7 years.

**2006, 2011, 2012: 1 event** (Women European Championship)

**2010: 2 events** (Women European Championship and Women European Cup)

**2005: 3 events** (Women European Championship Women European Cup and U19 Junior European Cup).

**2004: 1 event** (Women European Cup)

# Participation - ranking

# Participation - teams

Two countries count for almost half of all participating teams (total 460 teams): 45,87%

Germany: 112 teams (24,35%)

Switzerland: 99 teams (21,52%)

Great Britain: 65 teams (14,13%)

Denmark: 63 teams (13,70%)

Austria: 54 teams (11,74%)

Netherland: 36 teams (7,83%)

Israel: 13 teams (2,83%)

Poland: 12 teams (2,61%)

Russia: 6 teams (1,3%)

# Champions - rank

Germany wins almost every other Title  
Event the last 7 years: 45,28%

Germany: 24 titles (45,28%)

Switzerland: 13 titles (24,53%)

Denmark: 11 titles (20,75%)

Great Britain: 3 titles (5,66%)

Austria: 2 titles (3,77%)



# Champions – home and away

Home field advantage – last 7 years?

Hosting Country: 22 title events won (41,51%)

Visiting Country: 31 title events won (58,49%)

Apparently no home field advantage.

# Hosting events

Two countries have hosted appx. 70% of all title events: 67,93%

Germany: 20 events (37,74%)

Switzerland: 16 events (30,19%)

Denmark: 10 events (18,83%)

Austria: 6 events (11,32%)

Netherlands: 1 event (1,89%)

Only 5 countries have hosted Title Events the last 7 years.

# Requirement for hosting events

IISHF Regulations §18.8a (was implemented at the AGM 2009)

If in one calendar year a National Member Association takes part with a National Team on European Championship in a minimum of two different age groups (Men, Women, Junior).



# Requirement for hosting events

IISHF Regulations §18.8b (was implemented at the AGM 2009)

If in one calendar year a National Member Association takes part with its clubs/teams on European Cups in a minimum of three different age groups (Men, Women, Junior, Youth, PeeWee, Minnow).

# Requirement for hosting events

IISHF Regulations §18.8b (was implemented at the AGM 2009)

The National Member Association or one of it's clubs must host a class A event within five (5) years time frame beginning in this calendar year where the National Member Association fulfills the requirement of 18.a or 18b) subject to suitable venue.

2 Championships Regulations §18.8a
